The Director presented his report to the Committee. To date, the Committee has provided support worth £18,780 to help Bangor residents throughout the pandemic. The majority of the support has gone to the Food Share and Coed Mawr schemes, and both are very grateful for the Council's support since March 2020. In order to ensure that these schemes are sustainable going forward and rely less on financial support from the Council, it was suggested to invite Food Share and Coed Mawr representatives to the next meeting to discuss their plans, the timely submission of receipts and sustainable funding models. This is important as demand for food help and support will go beyond the pandemic.
